

A meeting of the Cranberry-Venango County General Authority was held on January 5, 2016. At 12:02pm the meeting was called to order by Vice-Chair Fred Ziegler. Fred Ziegler asked for a motion to approve the minutes from the December 1, 2015 meeting. Clair Schwab made the motion and a second was made by Rob Eakin – motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS

Jim Greenfield advised the board that he and Bonnie are still gathering information for delinquent accounts. He is also reviewing the legalities of the amendment to the 537 Plan.

SEWER AGREEMENT

There was discussion on the property owners of the land that has been mentioned for possible sites for a Waste Water Treatment Facility. Additional research will be provided at a later meeting.

WATER AGREEMENT

Rob Eakin advised the board members that he had received a quote for drilling a test well. Possible locations were discussed and will be discussed at the next scheduled meeting. The engineer will need to look at reports about aquifers in Cranberry Township. Chad will check with Chris Kogelnik to see if permits are needed when drilling test wells. The Authority is only investigating ground water sources at this time.
