



CRANBERRY TOWNSHIP PAVILION RENTAL AGREEMENT AND GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

The following rules and regulations are hereby established for the management and protection of the parks and recreation areas that currently are or may hereafter be acquired, leased, managed or established by Cranberry Township, Venango County:

Motor Vehicles and Bicycles must stay on established roadways and designated parking areas. NEVER block the main drives in case of emergency.

NO OFFENSIVE WEAPONS, FIREWORKS, ALCOHOL, GLASS BOTTLES OR UNLICENSED MOTORIZED VEHICLES are permitted in the Cranberry Township Parks.

No person shall injure, deface, remove, cut or damage any of the trees, plants, shrubs, grass, turf, buildings, structures or fixtures therein, or any other property of the township located within any park or recreation area.

Fires are permitted in grills only. No person shall set or maintain any fire in any park or recreation area except in grills.

No staples, tacks, or nails to anchor tablecloths to tables. No staples, tacks, or nails to attach anything to the Pavilion posts.

No person shall remove any bench, seat, table, grill, equipment or facilities from the park or recreation area or change the location thereof without permission.

No person shall conduct himself/herself within the park so as to annoy any other person occupying or using any park or recreational area.

No person shall dispose of any waste or garbage in the park or recreation area except in receptacles designated for the respective purpose. All persons using the park shall dispose of all waste and garbage left by them in such property receptacles. No person shall bring to and dispose of any waste or garbage in the park or recreation area.

No person shall bring alcoholic beverages into the park, either for his/her own use or consumption or for the use or consumption of any other person.

No person shall carry, possess or discharge any explosives, offensive weapons, slingshots, fireworks, arrows or other unlawful weapons within any park, playground or recreational area.

No person shall operate any motorcycle, all terrain vehicles, utility terrain vehicles, mini-bike, trail bike, motor vehicle or vehicles within any park or recreation area.

No person shall feed or cause any harm to wildlife at either park. This includes the geese at Moody Pond/Park

For the safety of animals and children, fishing lines and hooks need to be disposed of properly at Cranberry Parks.

Any person owning, possessing or controlling any dog may have the same within any park or recreation area of Cranberry Township are subject to the following conditions and restrictions:

- a. Dogs must be leashed or restrained at all times. No leash shall be longer than six (6') feet in length. All leashes or other control devices must be continuously maintained in the hand or hands of the person controlling the dog.**
- b. Dogs must have a valid Pennsylvania dog licenses and a rabies vaccination. Both need to be properly displayed upon the dog.**
- c. Dogs cannot be out of control under any circumstances. This includes barking or act in any manner so as to cause a disturbance of the peace of other persons within the parks.**

d. Dog owners shall carry with him or her suitable containers to immediately removes any waste and properly dispose of it. These provisions shall not apply to a guide dog accompanying a person with a disability.

The parks close at Dusk and gates will be locked.

Pavilion rental may be paid in Cash, Check or Money Order only. No refunds will be issued due to inclement weather. The Reservation form and payment must be returned to the Cranberry Township Office. A copy of these Rules and Regulation should accompany you on the day of the event.
