The regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Cranberry for April 22, 2021 was called to order by Harold Best Chairman. Those in attendance were Harold Best, Fred Buckholtz, Matt McSparren, and Chad Findlay (Township Manager). Guests were recorded in the attendance book. ADOPTION OF AGENDA

1. MINUTES

• Harold Best then asked for any additions or corrections to the minutes of the April 8, 2021 meeting. Matt McSparren made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Fred Buckholtz seconded, motion carried. (Harold Best - yes, Fred Buckholtz - yes, Matt McSparren - yes).

4. STAFF REPORTS -

• Township Manager – Chad Findlay announced that the Supervisors held an Executive Session on April 8th @ 11:00AM to discuss personnel. Chad then said that the ORA was selling a piece of property in the Industrial Park to a developer but sewer access was needed. They are requesting the Township to help with the installation of about 450' of sewer line to the property. After a brief discussion, Matt McSparren made a motion that the Township will provide the labor and the ORA will cover the cost of the materials for the sewer line extension. Fred Buckholtz seconded the motion and all voted in favor. (Harold Best - yes, Fred Buckholtz - yes, Matt McSparren - yes). Chad then announced that a scrap metal drop-off will be held on May 15th at the Township Building between 8AM and 12PM. Chad then presented the Supervisors with the low responsible bid for the paving project from IA Construction with low bid of \$626,272.46. Harold Best made a motion to approve the bid and Fred Buckholtz seconded the motion. (All voted in favor.) (Harold Best - yes, Fred Buckholtz - yes). Chad said road material bid packets were sent out and a bid opening is scheduled for May 27th @ 1:00PM. Chad then informed the Supervisors that Beth Harmon organized a bike trail clean up between Franklin and Oil City on April 28th between 5 and 8 PM for Northwest Bank's community days.

5. PUBLIC COMMENTS -

Ed Barrett asked why some roads get coated with tar & chip and some just get paved. He was told that it depended on the use and condition of the roads.
