- **Township Manager** – Chad Findlay informed the Supervisors that they were invited to the new Shoe Sensation ribbon cutting ceremony on April 22nd @ 8:45AM. Chad then said he attended a PSATS Town Hall virtual meeting to discuss the COVID relief money that the Townships will be getting. Cranberry Township is expecting to receive a total of \$617,233.00 over two payments between this June and June of 2022. Chad then said he met with PennDOT Officials to discuss the PennDOT Agility agreement. No major changes are expected and the Township intends to continue to do street sweeping in exchange for road line painting. Chad also said he and Ted visited Kenworth of Clintonville and with a representative from Hunter Truck Sales to work on truck pricing for the new truck that was budgeted for in 2021. Chad then reported that the Township paving bid will be advertised the next day and bids would be due and opened on April 15th @ 1:00PM. Lastly, Chad said that Steve Hartzell requested to be appointed to the Township Planning Commission to fill the current vacancy. Harold Best made a motion to appoint Steve Hartzell to the vacant Planning Commission seat and Matt McSparren seconded the motion. (All voted in favor.) (Harold Best - yes, Fred Buckholtz - yes, Matt McSparren - yes).

Scott Snow informed the Supervisor that he would soon be working on the Fireworks event and he would be asking the Township for their monetary donation.
